ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 2015

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ALIQUIPPA, ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 7 OF 2003 AND THEREAFTER AMENDED, WITH RESPECT TO CHAPTER 225 PART 1, ARTICLE 1 RECYCLING REGULATIONS, SECTION § 225-10, "SEPARATION AND COMPOSTING OF LEAF WASTE"

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Aliquippa, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS

The following words shall be incorporated in Section §225-2 of the Code of the City of Aliquippa:

LEAF WASTE; Leaves, garden residue, shrubbery and tree trimmings, and similar material, but not including grass clippings.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE

Chapter 225 of the Code of the City of Aliquippa is hereby amended to the following new Section 225-10:

§ 225-10 Separation and Composting of Leaf Waste


In compliance with State Act 1988-101, §1501 (c) (1) (ii), it is hereby required that Leaf waste be separated from ordinary household waste and composted.

SECTION 3: In all other respects, Chapter 225 Part 1 of the Code of the City of Aliquippa shall remain as heretofore enacted, ordained and amended, which said Chapter, as amended, is hereby re-enacted in its entirety herein.

SECTION 4: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any of its provisions shall prove to be unconstitutional, illegal or otherwise invalid, that decision shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or any other provision, section, article or chapter of the Code of the City of Aliquippa.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
