Highlights

National Library Week – Libraries across the country are celebrating National Library Week April 13-19 with a variety of events and activities. We will have activities and prizes in the Library all week long.

We will kick off the week with punch and cookies in the Library on Monday April 14.

Lucky Books will be scattered throughout the Library. Card holders who check out a Lucky Book any time during the week will win a small prize.

The Children's Story Time will feature Easter Egg stories and crafts. For adults, we have our Basic Computer Classes. See the Family Night program below.

We will also invite people to give the Library a hand by donating \$1 and putting their paper cut-out "hand" on the Library's window to show their support.

National Poetry Month – The Library will celebrate National Poetry Month with a Family Night program on April 16 entitled *Book Spine Poetry and Rhymes*. Families will work together to create free-style poetry using inspirations found in the Library. Children will have the opportunity to create their own rhymes and have a fun time.

Local poet Chadale Dye will read her poems and sign her books on Saturday afternoon April 26 at 2:00 in the Library.

Parent Teacher Resource Collection - The Library's resources for parents, teachers, and day care providers have been moved to a new set of shelves in the lobby of the Children's Library. We have material on parenting, family fun, nutrition, child development, programs for children, crafts, games, and information on working with children who have learning disabilities or special needs.
