Today, on April 12th, 2024, we celebrate the 87th Anniversary of the Supreme Court of the United States decision in National Labor Relations Board vs. Jones & Laughlin Steel Corporation. We must never forget the bravery and personal risk those ten men made from Aliquippa to change the course of the American labor movement.

On Tuesday morning, Congressman Christopher R.
