## The Beaver County Office on Aging announces the distribution of the 2024 Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program Vouchers

The vouchers <u>WILL BE DISTRIBUTED IN PERSON ONLY</u> beginning June 24 through August 2 at locations throughout the county.

Age and residency: Beaver County residents age 60 and over by December 31, 2024.

Income Guidelines: 1 person-\$27,861; 2 persons-\$37,814

Bring your ID with you to a distribution site.

What you will receive: Qualified individuals will receive five, \$10 vouchers, a \$50 value.

Proxy Forms: If you are physically unable to get to a distribution site, you can designate a proxy to pick up your vouchers. An individual can be a proxy for up to four older adults. The proxy form must be completed correctly, SIGNED BY THE ELIGIBLE OLDER ADULT RECIPIENT, as well as the proxy, and presented at the time of distribution.

When can vouchers be used?

They are valid from June through November 30, 2024.

Where can vouchers be used?

Redeem at PA Department of Agriculture approved Farmers Markets and Farm Stands in Beaver County or any other Pennsylvania county.

What can I purchase?

You may select Pennsylvania grown fruits, vegetables and cut herbs for cooking or flavoring.

Who sponsors the program?

The Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program is a program of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture, and the Beaver County Office on Aging is the local agency designated to oversee the distribution in our county.
