**PROCLAMATION
DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY**
City of Aliquippa, Beaver County, Pennsylvania

WHEREAS, the City of Aliquippa has experienced an extraordinary winter storm resulting in over fifteen (15) inches of snowfall, causing Borough roadways to become impassable, resulting in downed trees, widespread power outages, and other severe conditions impacting residents' ability to safely heat their homes and access essential services; and


WHEREAS, these conditions pose an immediate and continuing threat to the public health, safety, and welfare of residents of the Aliquippa; and

WHEREAS, the City of Aliquippa Public Works Department lacks sufficient snow removal equipment and resources to adequately address the magnitude of this emergency, thereby severely limiting the City's ability to maintain safe roadways and emergency access; and

WHEREAS, the City's ability to effectively respond to public safety needs is significantly compromised unless a Local Disaster Emergency is declared; and


WHEREAS, the Aliquippa City Council, in consultation with the Emergency Management Coordinator, has determined that an emergency exists and has formally requested that the Mayor declare a Local Disaster Emergency pursuant to Section 7501(b) of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa.C.S. § 7501(b)).

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Dwan B Walker, Mayor of the City of Aliquippa, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, do hereby proclaim and declare that a Local Disaster Emergency exists within the City Of Aliquippa, effective January 25, 2026, subject to formal ratification by the Aliquippa Council within seven (7) days.
